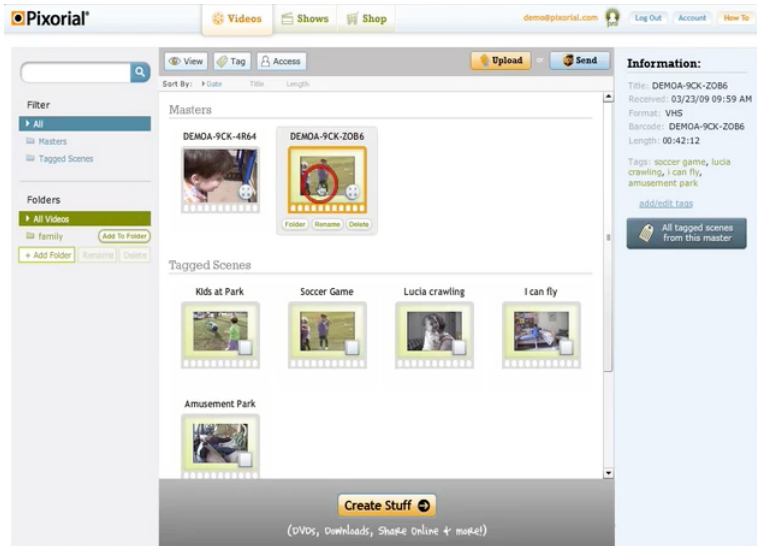


Editing Video in Producer

This Pixorial Tutorial covers how to edit video in Producer. The first to do is pick what you want to edit. You can start with a master video that you've either uploaded or sent in for conversion, or, if you tagged any scenes, you can click on one or more of those. To select more than one item, you hold down the Control key on a Windows machine or the Command key on a Mac, then select or deselect as the items you like. With the master selected, click on the Create Stuff button as that is how we'll get into Producer.



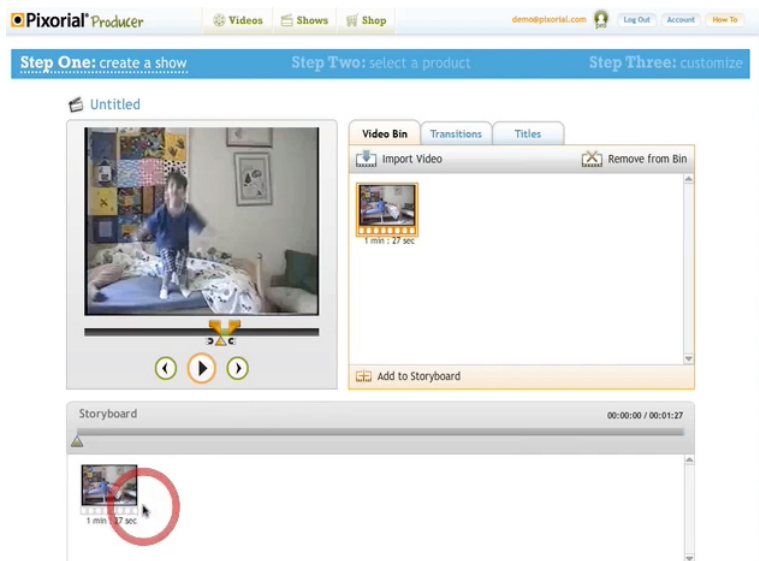
To make any product, you start by creating a Show. We tried to make that clear by displaying the step by step process at the top. Step One is to Create a Show, Step Two is to Select the product you would like to distribute, then Step Three is to add any customization if there is customization involved with the selected product.



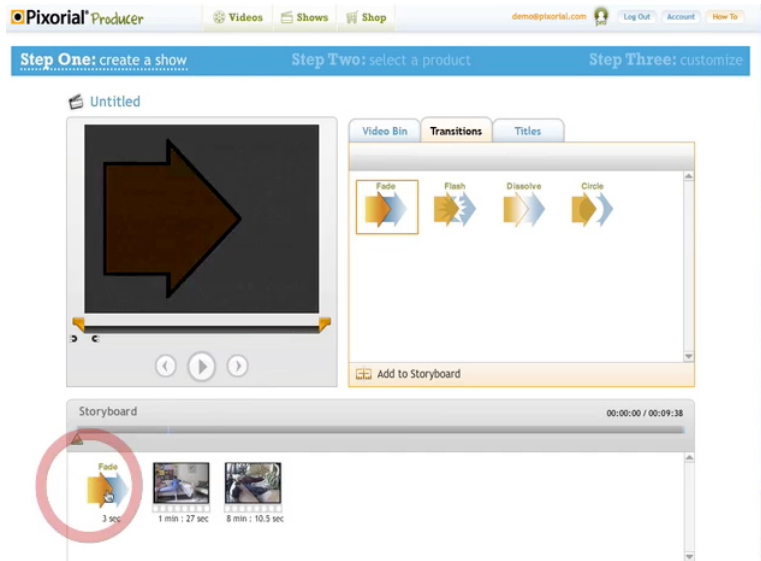
The first thing to do is navigate to a couple scenes within this master that you'll use for the show by dragging the playback head. Once you have the playback head at the start of this scene, click the left magnet to snap the Left Trimmer into place. This denotes the start of the scene.



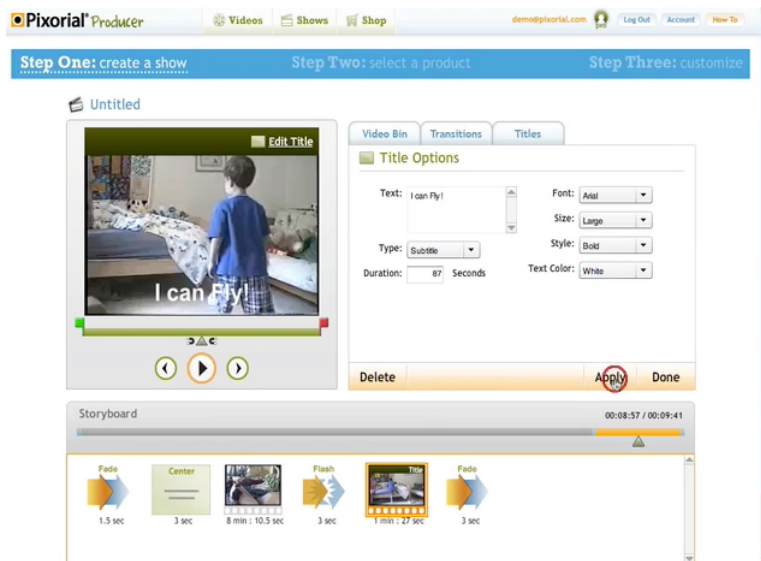
Now, drag the playback head down further to define the ending point of the scene. Once you have it where you want, click the right magnet to snap the Right trimmer to the end of the scene. Once you have the start and end points defined, add it to the storyboard. You can either drag it directly, click on the “Add to Storyboard” button, or simply double-click the clip. We are not really Editing video by cutting things out, we are simply identifying the scenes we want to include, then adding them to the storyboard. Your master video is never altered.



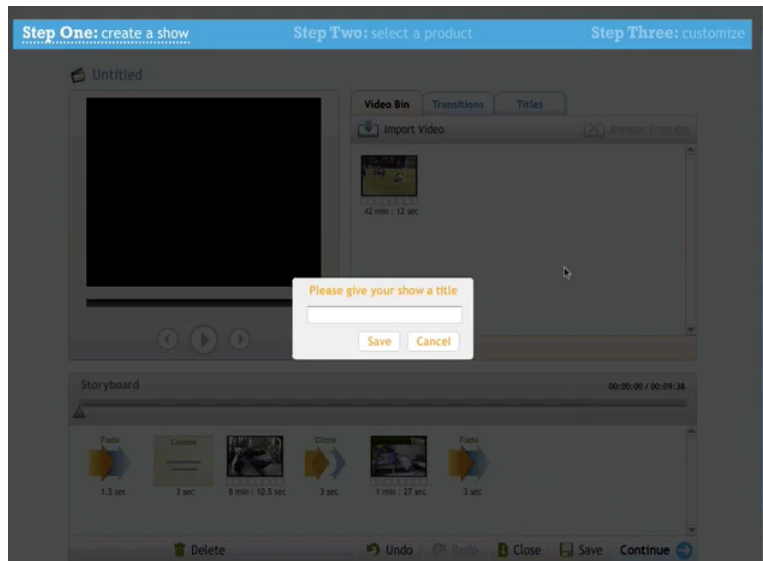
The next thing you might want to do is add a transition. You can “Fade In” to the first scene, do a Flash between the first and second scenes, then end with a Fade. To check any of the transitions, simply click on the transition and then click on the Play button to how you like it.



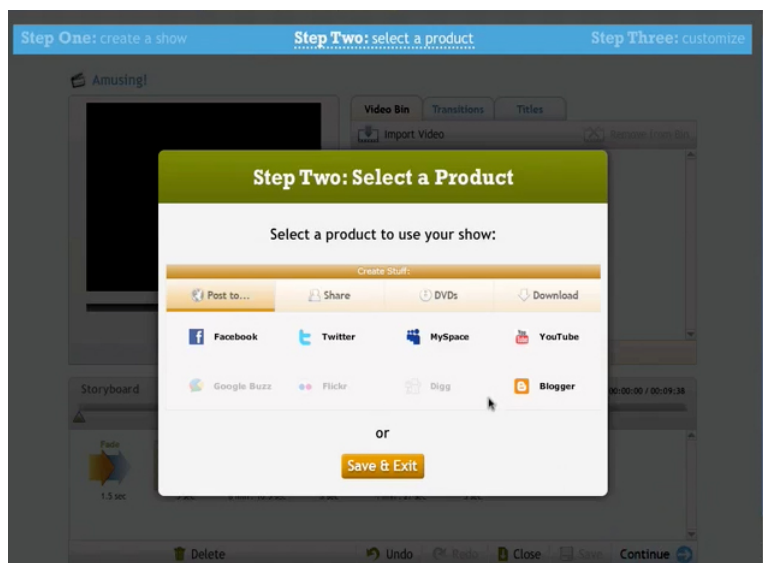
The final thing you may want to do is add a title. Click on Edit Title to enter the text and to specify other text options. When you're done, click the Apply button to see how it looks.



When you are finished, click "Save" and give your show a title.



Finally, select a product such as DVDs, Video eCards or post to your social networks like Facebook or YouTube*.



*Note: If you plan to post your video on Facebook or YouTube (for example), they have a 10 minute limit.
