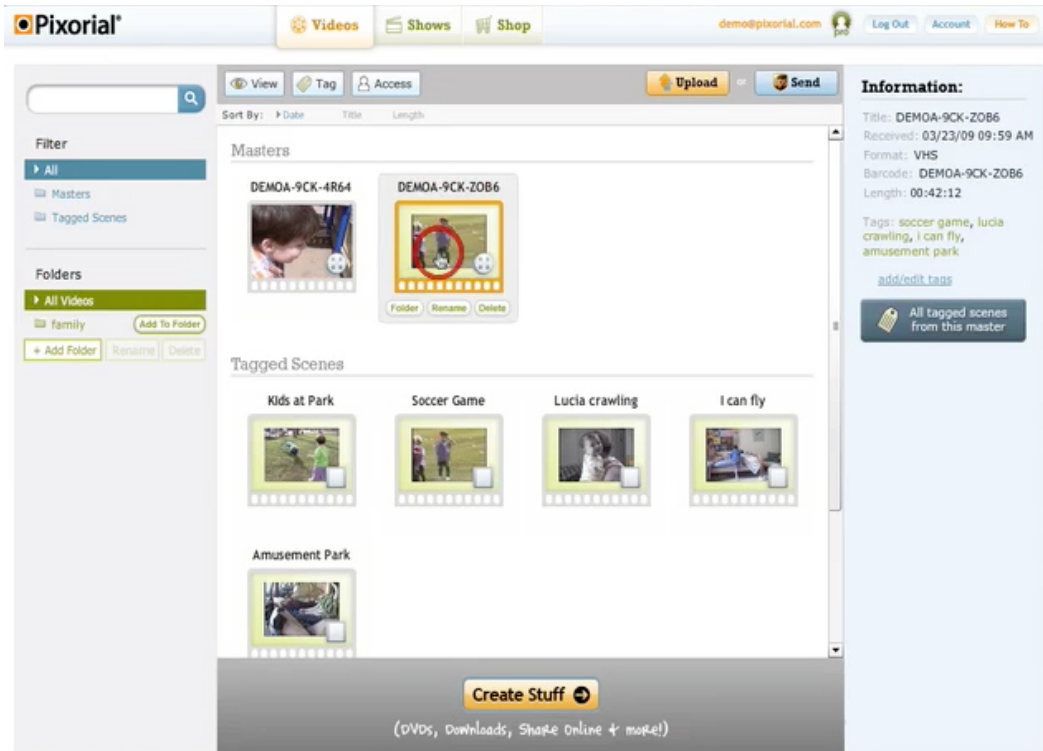


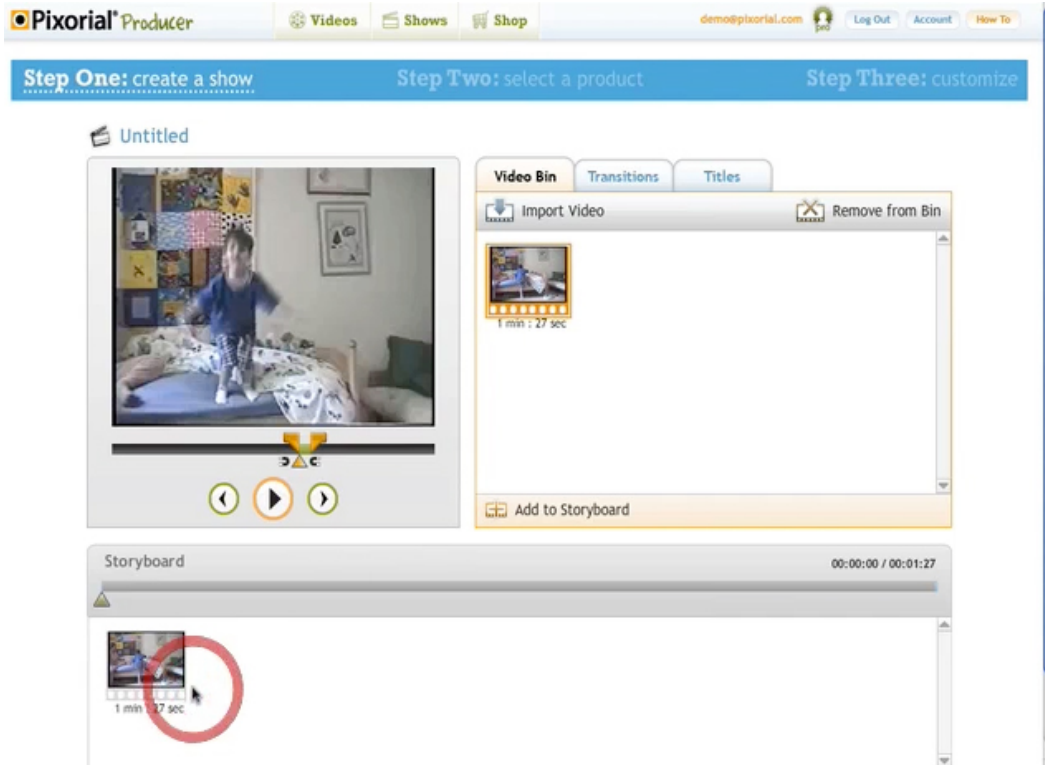
How to Create Video eCards

This Pixorial Tutorial covers how to create a Video eCard. You can start with a master video that you've either uploaded or sent in for conversion, or, if you've tagged any scenes, you can click on one or more of those. With the master selected, click on the Create Stuff button. This will launch Producer.

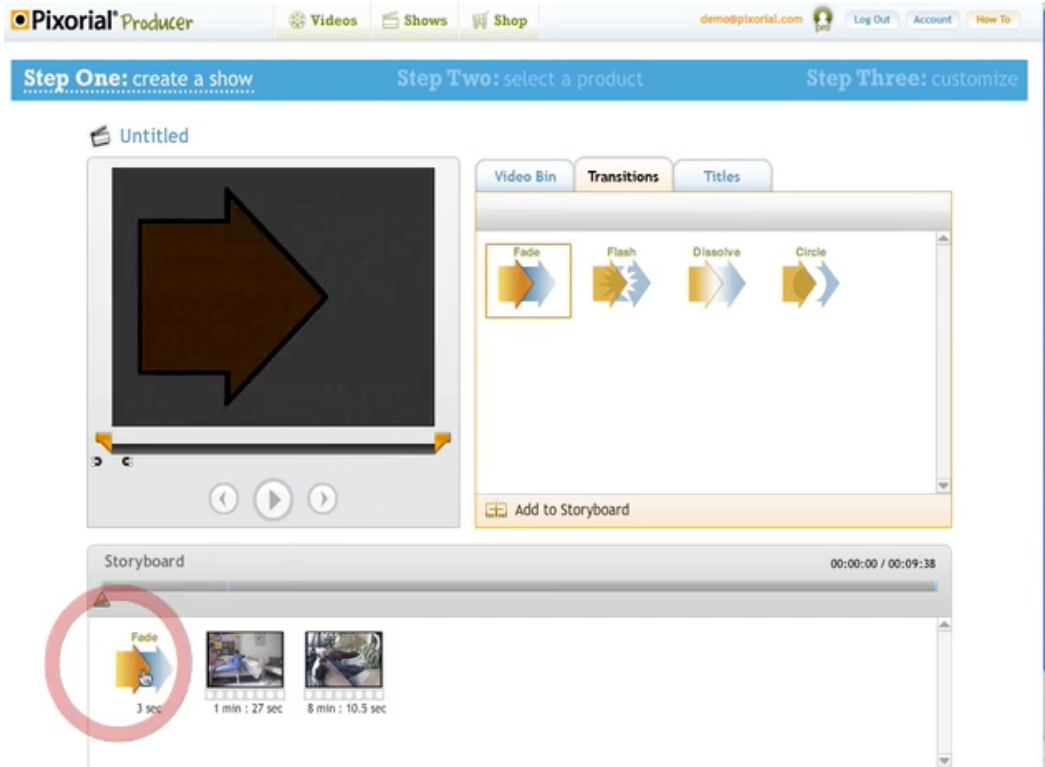


To make any product, you start by creating a Show. We tried to make that clear by displaying the step by step process at the top. Step One is to Create a Show, Step Two is to Select the product you would like to distribute, then Step Three is to customize the product if there is customization involved with the selected product.

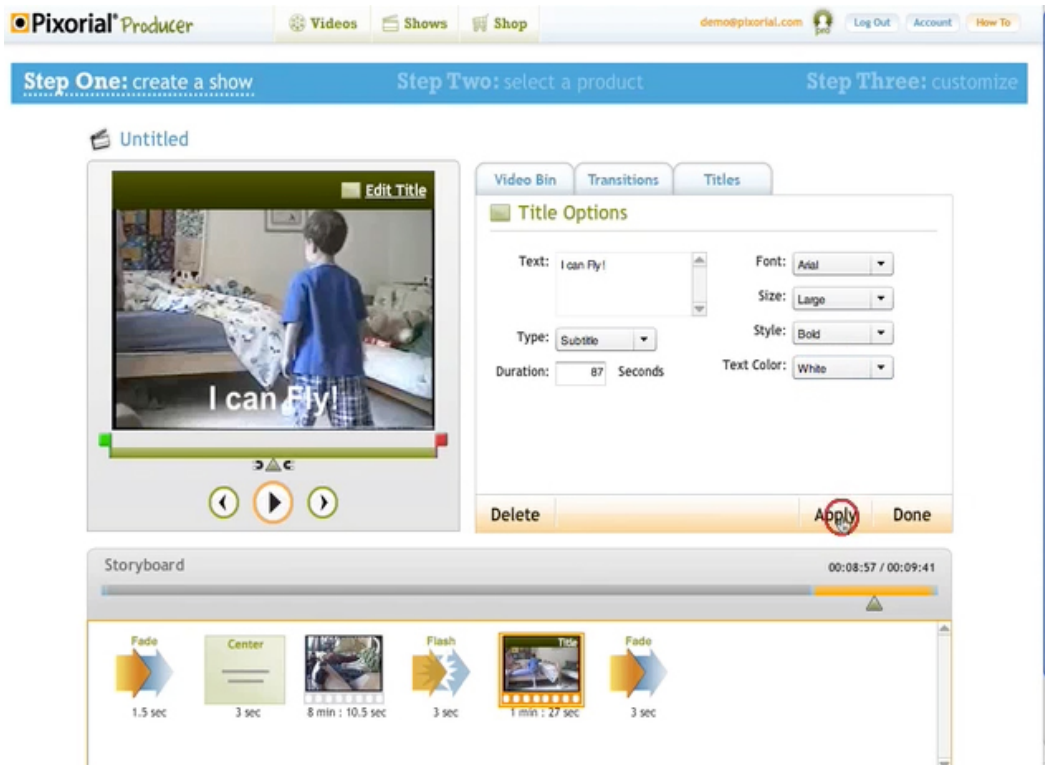
The first thing I want to do is drag the video clip to the Storyboard.



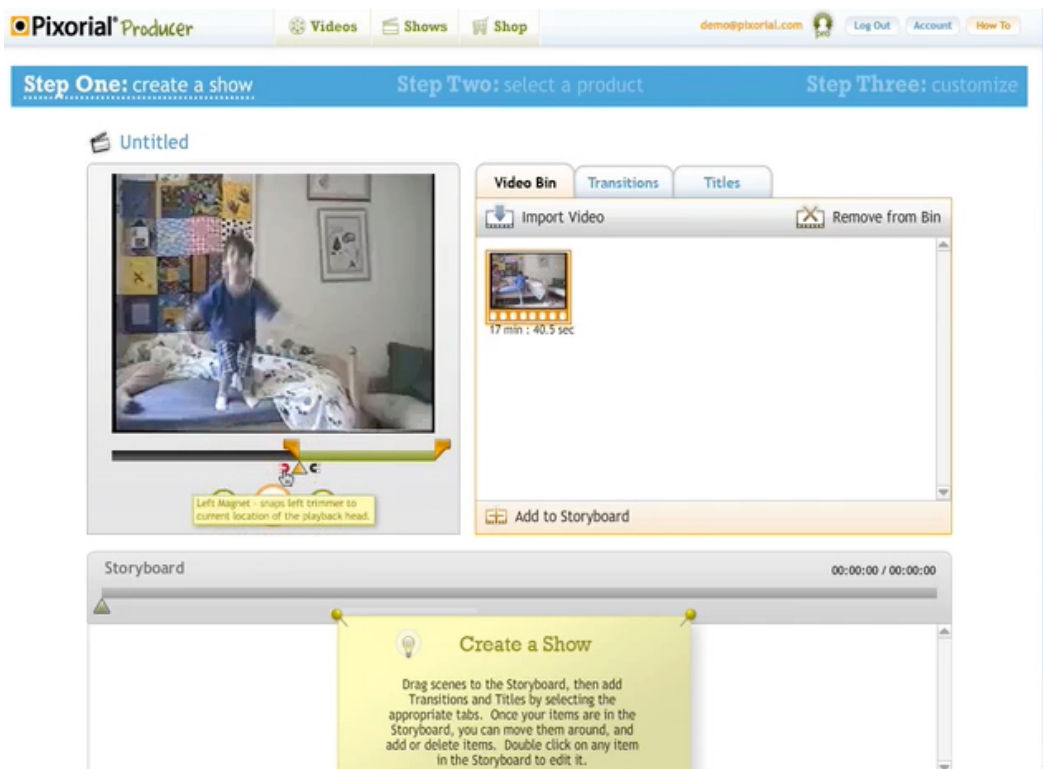
Once it's in the Storyboard, you can simply click Save and then continue on to the next step, or you might want to add a transition and a title. At the very least, it's nice to Fade In at the beginning and Fade out at the end.



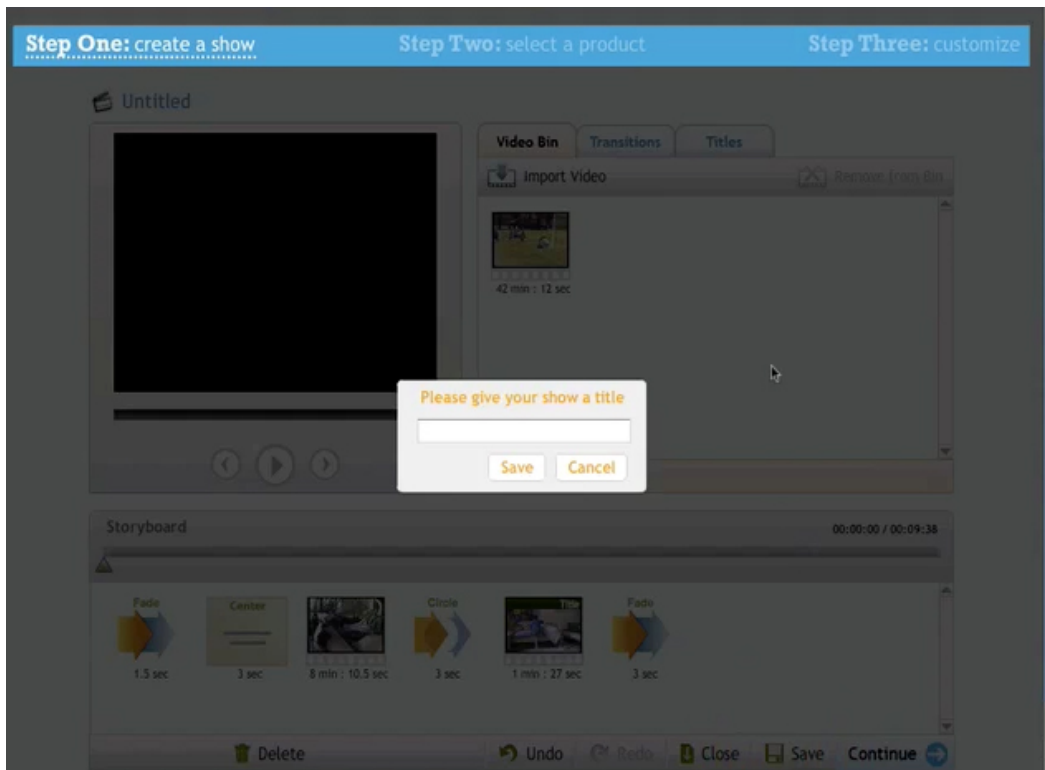
Then, add a title to introduce your show. Note that you can change the Font, the Size, the Style, and the Color of the text and then click “Apply”.



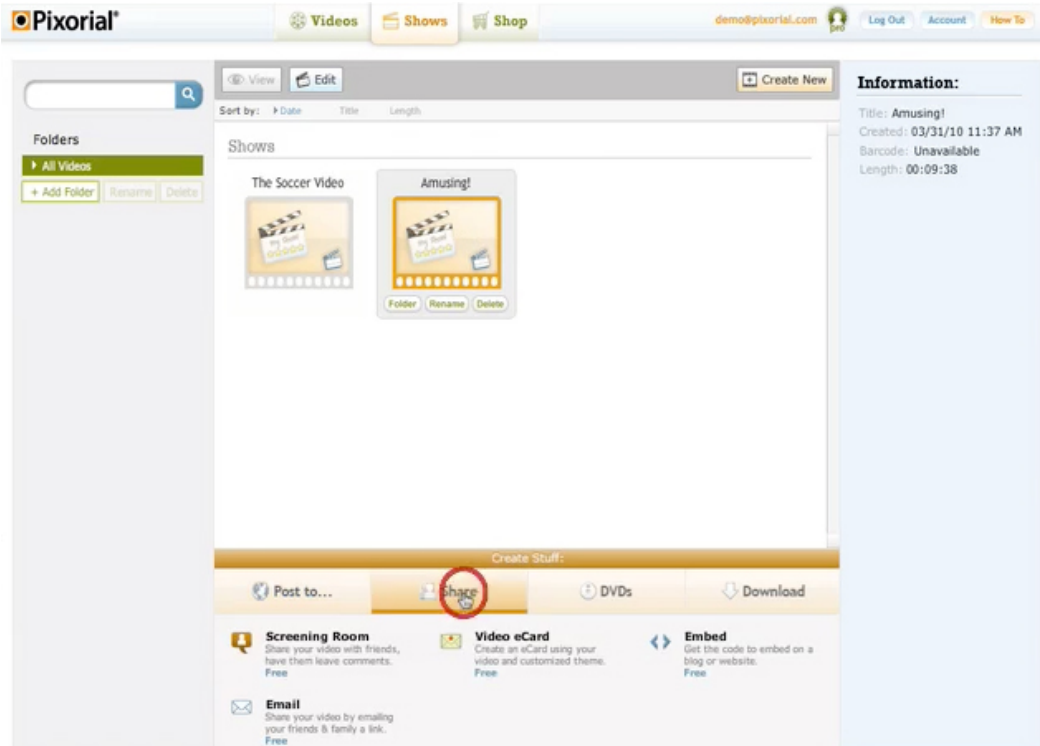
You can check how it looks by clicking on the Fade Transition and then press the play button. You can also check the transition at the end by doing the same. If an adjustment needs to be made, you can drag the left or right trimmer directly to make sure the video starts and ends at the right place.



Once you're happy with the show, save your video and give it a name.



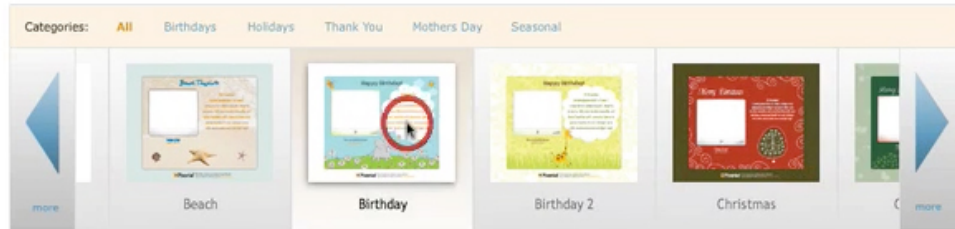
After saving, the next step is to click the Continue button. This will take you to a screen where you pick the product you would like to create or use to distribute your show. Click on the Share tab and then click on Video eCard.



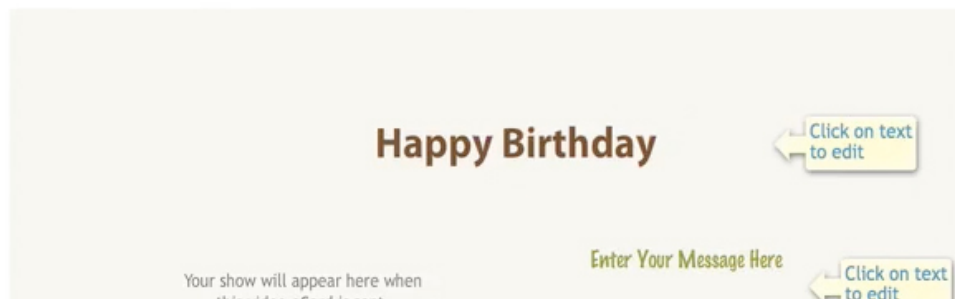
After you click on the Video eCard button you will be presented with a screen that will allow you to customize the design of the Video eCard. First select the design you would like to use.

2. Select Your Video eCard Template

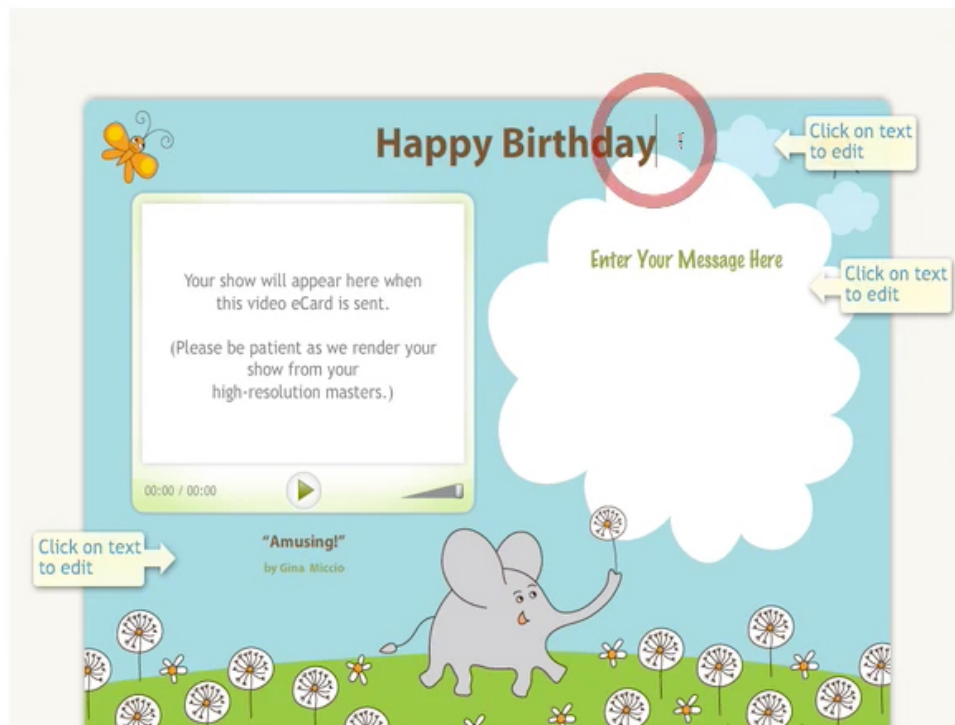


3. Customize Your Video eCard - All text areas are editable

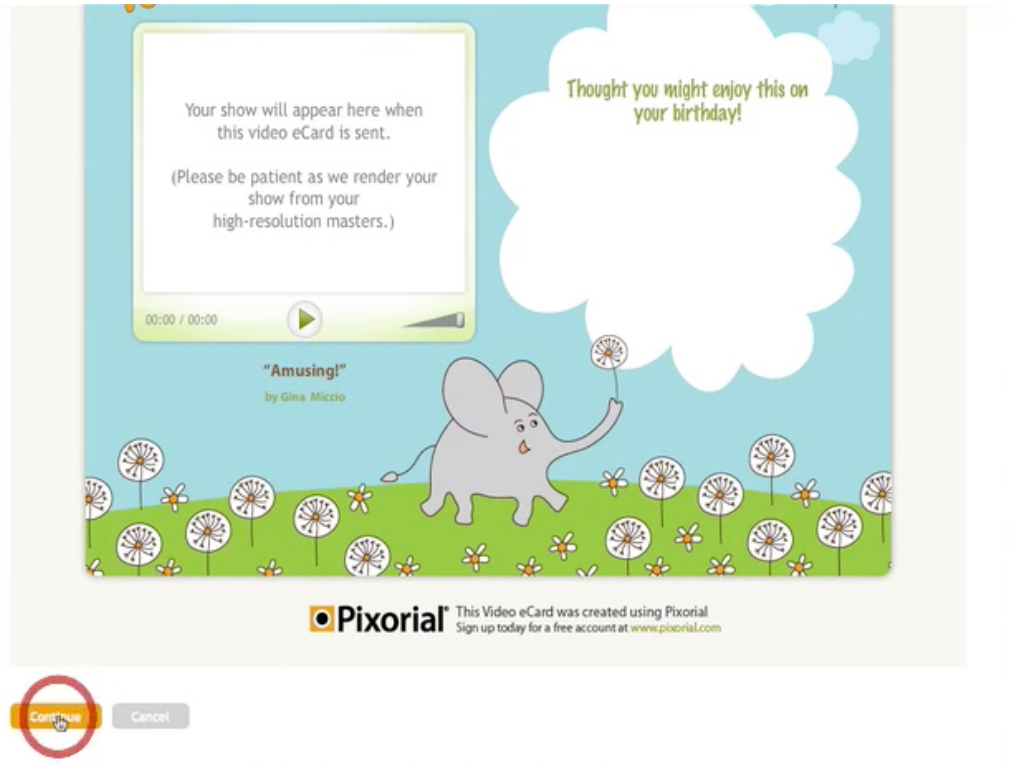


Customize the title areas.

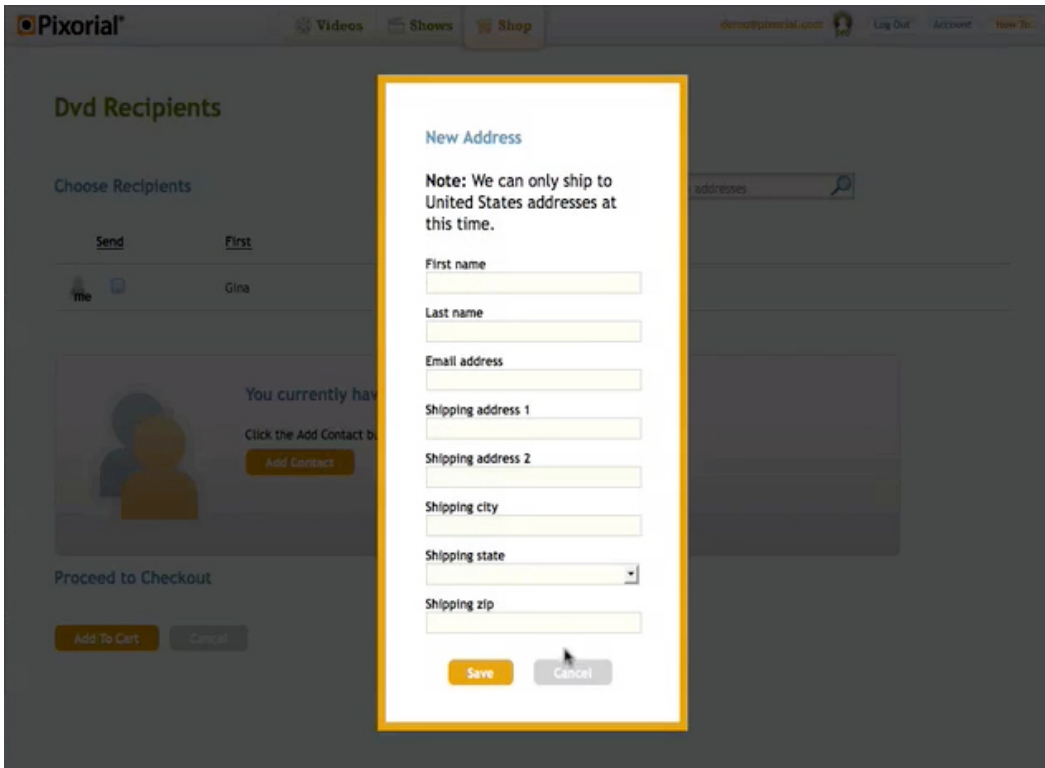

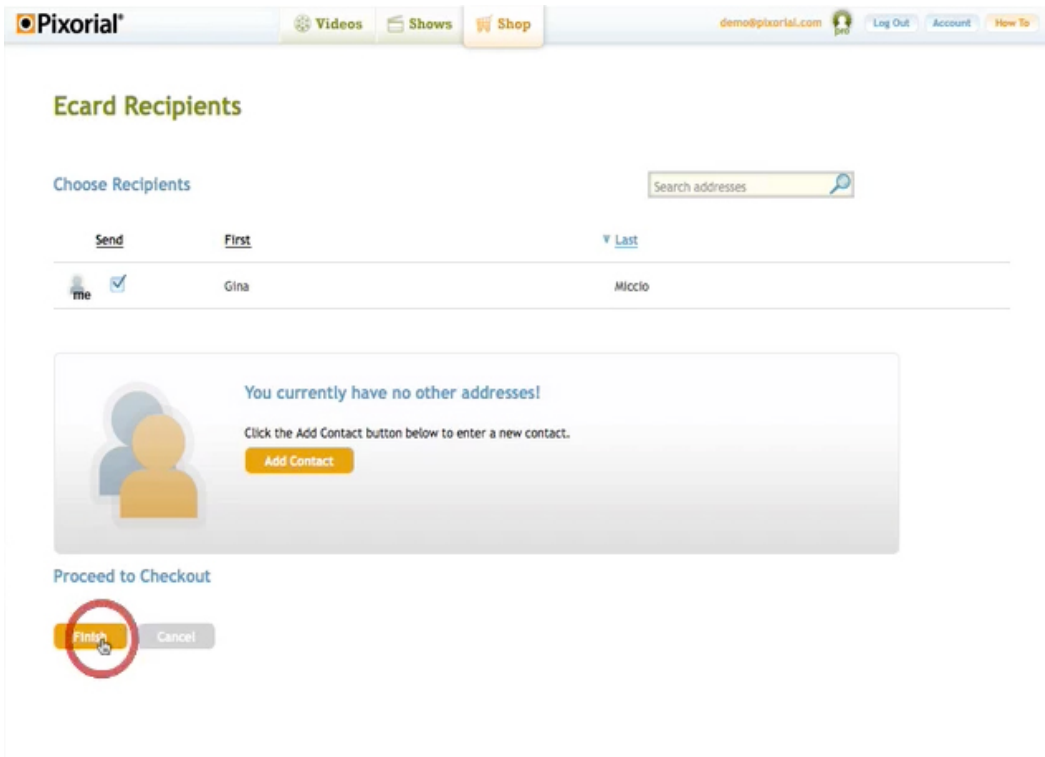
Once you're done with this, click the Continue button.



The next step is to choose to whom you would like to send the Video eCard. By default, the account holder's name is listed here, but you can also click the Add Contact button to add other people. To send a Video eCard you will need to include the email address of the person.



Then, click the Finish button.



Finally, you will receive an alert notifying you that your Video eCard has been sent.

✔ Your recipients will receive an email with a link to their Video eCard as soon as it is ready.


